

TITLE VIII - TRANSPORTATION  
CHAPTER 1 - STREETS and ALLEYS

ARTICLE 3  
BUILDING NUMBERING

8-1.0301 DEFINITIONS. For use in this chapter, the following terms are defined:

1. "Unit" means any dwelling unit or commercial unit that is in any building or a portion thereof, which is designed or exclusively used for separate residential or commercial purposes.

8-1.0302 PROPERTY OWNER REQUIREMENTS. The property owner shall comply with the following numbering requirements:

1. Obtain Address Number. The property owner shall obtain the assigned number to the unit from the Clerk's office.
2. Display Address Number. The property owner shall place or caused to be installed and maintained on the unit, the assigned number in a conspicuous place to the street or the primary entrance of the unit, in figures not less than three (3) inches in height and of contrasting color with their background.
3. Failure to Comply. If a property owner refuses to number a unit as herein provided, or fails to do so for a period of thirty (30) days after being notified in writing by the City to do so, the City may proceed to place the assigned number on the unit and assess the costs against the property for collection in same manner as a property tax.

8-1.0303 ADDRESS NUMBERING PLAN. Address numbers shall be assigned in accordance with the building numbering plan on file in the office of the Clerk.
