January 5, 2009

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 5, 2009, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Wilson, Stoeffler, Woods, Short, Dodd. Absent: None.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve the minutes of the December 1, 2008, regular meeting as presented. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports and funding requests from the following: Colo Senior Citizens, Colo Food Pantry, ACCESS, Community & Family Resources, Good Neighbor Fund, Legal Aid of Story County, Youth and Shelter Services, RSVP, Heartland Senior Services, Colo Public Library and Colo Fire & Rescue.

Wanda Carlson and pat McIntosh gave a report on the Winter Festival and requested that the Council find a new chairperson for next year.

Wilson moved to table action on "Quiet Zones". Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, APPROVING PRELIMINARY PLANS, AND FIXING A DATE FOR HEARING THEREON AND TAKING OF BIDS THEREFOR. Council

member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Short, Stoeffler, Dodd, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 09-1-1 for the record.

Council member Wilson moved to approve a Request For Proposals for the preliminary design and estimate of cost for a building addition to and the remodeling of the Colo Community Center building. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short moved to approve the following appointments: Colo Planning and Zoning Commission (5 year terms) David Swanson and Ellen Woods. Colo Zoning Board of Adjustment (5 year terms) Liz Robinson and Fred Cerka. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Mayor Milleson discussed the need to find a new chairperson for the 2009 Colo Crossroads Festival.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Stoeffler moved to adjourn. Council member Wilson seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
