

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
January 6, 2014

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 6, 2014, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council members Paul Conrad, Diane Nichols, Larry Milleson (elected) and Earl Otto (appointed) were administered the oath of office in the month of December 2013. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Nichols, Norgart, Milleson, Conrad. Absent: None.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the minutes of the December 2, 2013, regular meeting and the December 21, 2013 special meeting as presented. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received funding requests for the fiscal year ending 6-30-15 from the following organizations: Colo Food Pantry, Youth and Shelter Services, RSVP, Good Neighbor Emergency Assistance, Heartland Senior Services, Story County Legal Aid, Colo Soccer Club, ACCESS, Colo Senior Citizens, Mid-Iowa Community Action, Salvation Army, Colo Wrestling Club, Colo Crossroads Festival, Colo Public Library, Colo Recreation Board, and Colo Fire & Rescue.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Department, the Colo Public Library, Colo Crossroads Committee, and Colo Fire and Rescue.

The Council and recreation board had a discussion regarding the wrestling program combining with Nevada and leaving the Colo Recreation program.

Council member Norgart introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE SALE OF WATER IN THE CITY OF COLO. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Otto, Norgart, Milleson, Nichols, Conrad.

Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution adopted and he gave it Number 14-1-1 for the record.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the following appointments: City Clerk/Treasurer –Scott Berka, Fire Chief – Mark Farren, City Attorney – Dario Zaffarano, Zoning Board of Adjustment – Elizabeth Robinson and Fred Cerka, Planning and Zoning Commission – Dave Swanson. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad moved to authorize the city clerk to execute a “Receipt and Waiver” on behalf of the Colo Cemetery and the Colo Public Library for the Doris J. House estate, subject to approval by the city attorney. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes,

Council member Conrad moved to approve a contract with L.L.Pelling Co. for the 2014 street seal coating project. Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad moved to approve tax abatement for a building addition at 811 Sixth St. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council discussed the upcoming contract for disposal of solid waste with the Ames Resource Recovery Plant. The council directed the clerk to check on the possibility of using the Marshall County Landfill for solid waste disposal.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the expenditure of \$100.00 to the Colo-Nesco After Prom Committee. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Milleson moved to direct the city attorney to prepare an ordinance amendment requiring the appointment of city council members to the Colo Recreation Board. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council discussed the City Clerk/Maintenance Superintendent position. A job description will be completed for the February regular meeting.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Norgart moved to adjourn. Council member Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
