February 2, 2009

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, February 2, 2009, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Wilson, Woods, Short. Absent: Dodd, Stoeffler.

Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received funding requests from MICA and the Richmond Center. Reports were received from the Story County Sheriffs Department, Colo Recreation Board and The Colo Cemetery society.

The Council reviewed a proposed agreement for fire protection with Sherman and New Albany Townships. Council member Wilson moved to table action on the agreement until the March regular meeting pending approval by the townships. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Dodd moved to approve the 6-Year Capital Improvements Program as proposed by the Colo Planning And Zoning Commission. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed the status of the Storm Drainage Improvement Project. Bid letting is scheduled for February 12, 2009.

The Council discussed the Community Center Improvement Project. Proposals for preliminary design are due on February 16, 2009. Mayor Milleson, Council members Stoeffler and Wilson and the city clerk will meet to review the proposals received before the next regular meeting.

The Council reviewed the proposed city budget for fiscal year ending 6-30-2010. Council member Short moved to set the date of March 2, 2009, at 7:30 p.m. for a public hearing on the FYE 6-30-2010 budget. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Woods moved to adjourn. Council member Short seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
