February 4, 2013

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, February 4, 2013, at City Hall. Mayor Protem Patrick Peakin called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Nichols, Norgart, Patrick. Absent: Conrad.
