

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
March 3, 2008

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, March 3, 2008, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Woods, Short, Stoeffler. Absent: Dodd, Wilson.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve the minutes of the February 4, 2008, meeting as presented. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Jennifer Dulaney and James Chevalier provided information on the Colo Soccer Club and presented a funding request for the Council's consideration.

Council member Wilson arrived at 7:20 p.m.

At 7:30 p.m. the Mayor announced that this was the time and the place for a public hearing on the City of Colo operating budget for fiscal year ending 6-30-09. There were no comments received and the hearing was closed. Council member Wilson moved to change the line item expenditure for the fiscal year 2008-09 budget for the Colo Pre-School to the Colo Soccer Club. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes. Council member Short introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ADOPTING BUDGET AND CERTIFICATION OF TAXES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2008 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2009. Council member Woods seconded the motion and passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Short, Wilson, Stoeffler, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-3-1 for the record.

Josh Eaton, candidate for Iowa House District 10, spoke to the Council.

Tom Crane spoke to the Council regarding the possible sale of property he owns to the city.

Mayor Milleson announced the appointment of the following citizens to the Colo RAGBRAI Committee: Dee Carlson, Kim Adams, Joanie Jamison, Dorothy Cerka, John Wilson, Joe Harper Co-Chairperson, Kevin Bell, Diane Bell, Lewis Flanigan, Nancy Tucker, Mike Gaedke Co-Chairperson, and Dennis Hapes. Council member Wilson moved to approve a RAGBRAI XXXVI pass-through town agreement with the Des Moines Register and Tribune Company. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION WAIVING THE CITY OF COLO'S RIGHT TO REVIEW THE SANDVE FAMS, INC. AGRICULTURAL SUBDIVISION. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Stoeffler, Woods, Short. Nays: None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-3-2 for the record.

Council member Short introduced and moved the approval of A RESOLUTION APPROVING FINAL ACCEPTANCE AND FINAL PAYMENT FOR THE REED/NILAND PHASE III RESTORATION PROJECT. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Stoeffler, Short, Wilson. Nays: None. Whereupon the mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-3-3 for the record.

The Council reviewed a proposed resident satisfaction survey as submitted by the Colo Planning and Zoning Commission.

Council member Stoeffler gave a report on behalf of the Community Center Planning Committee.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the appointment of Kylee Fleming to the Colo Planning and Zoning commission. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods moved to appoint Dennis Clatt and Mike Walker to the Colo Recreation Board. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve the expenditure of \$100.00 to the Colo-Nesco After Prom Party Committee. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
