

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
April 2, 2007

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 2, 2007, at City Hall. Mayor John Foley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Snodgrass, Wilson, Woods, Stoeffler. Absent: None.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2007, meeting as presented. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Colo Recreation Board, the Colo Public Library, and the Story County Sheriff's Office.

Nevada Police Chief Mike Tupper presented a proposal for law enforcement services for the City.

Tony Bellizzi of Veenstra & Kimm engineering presented the final report of the storm drainage and street improvement study.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve a request from Willard's Harley Repair to close a portion of Main Street between Third and Fourth Street and a portion of Fourth Street north of Main street on May 19, 2007, for a street dance. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Stoeffler gave a report for the Community Center Planning Committee. The committee met recently and will talk to Iowa State University to see if consultant help is available through the university.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve a program to assist Colo residents with cleanup of tree debris from the February ice storm with a deadline of April 16, 2007, for residents to have the debris at the street for pick up. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson moved to approve a contract with Steffes Construction, Inc. for the 2007 street seal-coating contract. Council member Snodgrass seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Otto moved to approve a request from The Colo Bar for an expanded outdoor service area on May 19-20, 2007, as per sketch attached to the permit application. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

Richard Collins addressed the Council regarding the sale of Lot 13, Block 11, Blair's Addition.

The Council directed the clerk to contact Simmering-Cory regarding a possible Community Development Block Grant application for a storm drainage project.

The clerk advised the Council of recent correspondence from Central Iowa Water Association regarding an increase in the price of water sold to the City.

Laura Bell of Youth and Shelter Services requested that the City Council consider tobacco-free policies for outdoor sports facilities owned by the City. The Council referred the matter to the Recreation Board for a recommendation.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Woods moved to adjourn. Council member Snodgrass seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
