

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
April 4, 2011

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 4, 2011, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Wilson, Short. Absent: Hess, Woods.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2011, meeting as presented. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriffs Department and the Colo Recreation Board.

Council member Woods arrived at 7:40 p.m.

The Council reviewed gas and electric franchise agreements with Interstate Power and Light Company. Council member Wilson moved to set the date of May 2, 2011, at 7:30 p.m. for a public hearing on natural gas and electric franchise ordinances with Interstate Power and

Light Co. Said ordinances to contain franchise fees in the amount of 4 percent with the revenue purpose to be all uses allowed by section 384.3A of the Code of Iowa. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council discussed possible long term street improvements. The matter will be referred to the Planning and Zoning Commission for consideration in capital improvements planning.

Council member Woods moved to approve a contract with Kluesner Construction, Inc. for street crack sealing. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION FIXING DATE FOR A MEETING ON THE AUTHORIZATION OF A LOAN AND DISBURSEMENT AGREEMENT AND THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$20,000 SEWER REVENUE CAPITAL LOAN NOTES OF COLO, IOWA, AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION OF NOTICE THEREOF. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Wilson, Short Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution approved and he gave it No. 11-4-1 for the record.

The Council reviewed a request to install yield signs on South Street at the intersection of Fifth Street and remove yield signs on Fifth Street at the intersection of South Street. No action taken.

The Council discussed possible nuisance abatement.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Short seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
