

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
April 4, 2016

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 4, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows:

Dennis Clatt from the Colo Fire Department reported there were ten calls this past month. The department has a new member, Zack Imler.

The FYE 6-30-15 audit report was discussed. New policies and procedures are being drawn up.

The city's water meter reader was discussed. Clerk Kohlwes reported the city's current reader needs to be replaced. Further information is being gathered.

Central Iowa Water Association met with the council to discuss hooking Hickory Grove Park and the County Living Mobile Home Park up to the city's lagoon. Further information is being gathered by the city and Central Iowa Water Association.

Clayton Miller discussed the city accepting a Recycler's License from the state. The city believes his property is not in the correct zoning. More information is being gathered.

Gabe Starling addressed the council on adding emergency lighting to the Library and Community Center. All agreed this would be done.

Jason Modrow addressed the council on changing the city ordinance allowing chickens. The council agreed to look into the issue. More information is being gathered.

Council member Nichols discussed the need for a dog poop pick up stations at the city parks. More information is being gathered.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Conrad moved to adjourn. Council member Nichols seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
