April 6, 2020

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, April 6, 2020 at the Community Center. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Arlo Starbuck. Council member Geisinger introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO TAKE APPROPRIATE EMERGENCY MEASURES DURING THE COVID-19 PANEMIC IN THE CITY OF COLO, IA. Council member Adams seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Adams, Stoeffler and Geisinger. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 20-4-1 for the record.

Council member Stoeffler introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY CLERK TO APPROVE PAID EMPLOYEE LEAVE DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC IN THE CITY OF COLO. Council member Adams seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Adams, Stoeffler and Geisinger. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 20-4-2 for the record.

The FC&A Club would like to donate a metal Colo dog for the City sign. All agreed that was ok so the council will be presented with options.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Geisinger moved to adjourn. Council member Adams seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
