

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
May 2, 2016

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 2, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows:

Present: Conrad, Otto, Nichols, Milleson, Geisinger. Absent: none.

Council member Otto moved to approve the minutes of the April 4, 2016 regular meeting as presented.

Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Joanie Jamison from the Colo Public Library discussed the summer reading program will be starting June 2. This year a meal will be served for those attending from 6:00 p.m. – 6:30 p.m. Program will go from 6:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Laura Bell from Youth and Shelter Services discussed options they could help citizens out with.

Andrew Boeckman from the Story County Sheriff's Office gave a report. Call volumes have been up. The officer stated to make sure citizens report suspicious vehicles or people in town.

Council member Otto introduced a RESOLUTION APPROVING PAYMENT ON TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Nichols, Milleson, Geisinger, Otto, Conrad. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it No 16-5-1.

Council member Nichols introduced a RESOLUTION APPROVING PAYMENT ON TAX INCREMENT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Nichols, Milleson, Geisinger, Otto, Conrad. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it No 16-5-2.

Garbage collection was discussed. It was agreed citizens need to be abiding by the ordinance.

A chicken ordinance was discussed. Council member Nichols moved to approve allowing 6 chickens and no roosters within city limits. Council member Milleson seconded the motion and it did not pass.

Clayton Miller discussed the city accepting a Recycler's License from the state. Planning and Zoning recommended to the Council to decline accepting the license. More information is being gathered.

Council member Milleson moved to approve the City's Performance Review Policy. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Milleson moved to adjourn. Council member Nichols seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
