

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
May 5, 2008

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, May 5, 2008, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Woods, Short, Dodd, Wilson. Absent: Stoeffler.

Council member Woods moved to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2008, regular meeting and April 23, 2008, special meeting as presented. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Department, Colo Public Library and the Colo Crossroads Committee, and the Colo Cemetery Board.

Joe Harper gave a report for the Colo RAGBRAI Committee. Council member Wilson moved to authorize the expenditure of up to \$1000.00 for use by the Colo RAGBRAI Committee with the condition that no expenditure be made prior to 7-1-08. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Dodd introduced and moved the approval of an ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COLO CITY CODE BY ADDING A SECTION ENTITLED "RAGBRAI-MISCELLANEOUS PERMITS" . Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Short, Dodd, Wilson, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance approved on first reading.

At 8:00 p.m. the Mayor announced that this was the time and the place for a public hearing on an amendment to the Fiscal Year Ending 6-30-08 budget. There were no comments received and the hearing was closed.

Council member Wilson introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING 6-30-08 CITY BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Dodd, Wilson, Woods, Short. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-5-1 for the record.

The Council discussed a request to leave the restrooms at the city parks unlocked. No action taken.

Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2008. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Woods, Short, Dodd. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-5-2 for the record.

Council member Wilson introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Short, Dodd, Wilson. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution approved and he gave it No. 08-5-3 for the record.

Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Short, Dodd, Wilson, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution approved and he gave it No. 08-5-4 for the record.

The council discussed financing options for the Storm Sewer Project. The council directed the city clerk to work with the city attorney to draft an ordinance establishing a storm sewer utility.

The council reviewed a resignation letter from the city newsletter editor.

The council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

The council reviewed a letter from Central Iowa Water Association regarding an increase in the cost of water.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
