

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
June 1, 2015

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 1, 2015, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Nichols, Conrad, Milleson. Absent: Geisinger.

Council member Otto moved to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2015, meeting as presented. Council member Milleson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Milleson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Nichols gave an update on the Colo Crossroads Festival. The Story County Sherriff stated more officers will be on patrol throughout the county. Traffic accidents have increased due to fog. The council had concerns on a few citizens with booming music. The officer is paying a visit to those individuals. Joanie Jamison from the Colo Public Library gave an update on a study done on state libraries throughout Iowa. Colo has a B size library with the highest circulation. The city wide garage sales scheduled for June 12th and 13th is coming together. LeAnn Harter from Story County presented the Story County Comprehensive Plan (C2C Plan). The plan will help guide communities and show them how to grow and develop over the next 20 years. A community meeting will be on June 23, 2015 at the Colo Community Center at 6:00 p.m.

Council member Conrad introduced a RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING 6-30-15. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Conrad, Nichols, Otto, and Milleson. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 15-6-1 for the record.

Council member Otto introduced a RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING 2015-2016. Council member Milleson seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Conrad, Nichols, Otto, Milleson. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 15-6-2 for the record.

Council member Milleson introduced a RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF COLO, IA. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Conrad, Nichols, Otto, Milleson. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 15-6-3 for the record.

Sewer rates were discussed and tabled to next meeting.

Discussions on the Emerald Ash Borer were made. The clerk applied for an Alliant Energy grant to purchase new trees to help replace some of the Ash trees in Central Park and Carmody Park.

Council member Nichols moved to approve the cigarette permit for Casey's General Stores, council member Milleson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Milleson moved to approve Pay Request Number 5 for 2014 Street Improvement Project. Council member Conrad seconded the motion, it passed all ayes.

In other business, all agreed to install 25 mph signs along South Street. Discussions on selling the city's vacant lot at 302 Warner Street. Council member Milleson moved to approve a listing price of \$15,000, council member Nichols seconded the motion, it passed all ayes.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Milleson moved to adjourn. Council member Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
