June 3, 2019

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, June 3, 2019 at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Stoeffler, Geisinger, Otto and Spalding. Absent: Handsaker

Council member Otto moved to approve the minutes of the May 6, 2019 regular meeting as presented and the minutes of May 23, 2019 special meeting as presented. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all eyes.

Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Story County Sheriff, Jordan Lenz said things have been slow. He informed the council there will be a new officer in charge of Colo starting July 1.

Librarian, Joanie Jamison announced the library has received another STEM grant from Alliant. They also received an \$800 grant from Story County United way to help supply food for the summer reading program.

Council member Otto introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION SETTING THE SALARIES FOR APPOINTED OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes Stoeffler, Spalding, Geisinger, Otto. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 19-6-1.

Council member Spalding introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION TRANSFERING FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes Stoeffler, Spalding, Geisinger, Otto. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 19-6-2.

Council member Otto introduced and moved the approval of RESOLUTION FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING 6-30-19. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes Stoeffler, Spalding, Geisinger, Otto. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 19-6-3.

Council member Spalding moved to approve new Library Board members: Nancy Henry, Carla Smith, and Kendra Eibs. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Otto moved to approve the Dog House's outdoor sales Colo Days on July 13th. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger moved to approve a \$1,000 donation to the Colo Fireworks Committee. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve Casey's General Stores cigarette permit. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The storm sewer on Sixth Street was discussed. Clerk Kohlwes is gathering more information.

Discussions of the Fire Department parking lot was tabled to the next meeting.

Discussions of the City Hall shop floor were made.

The housing development was discussed. More information is being gathered.

Clerk Kohlwes told the council she is going to apply for the Story County Community Foundation Grant to help renovate the Community Center. Council member Spalding is getting an architect to help with the renovations.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Stoeffler moved to adjourn. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
