Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Department, Colo Recreation Board, Colo Fire & Rescue and the Colo Crossroads Committee.

Council member Conrad moved to approve the expenditure of \$1500.00 to the Colo Crossroads Festival Committee. Council member Patrick seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Rick Halverson and Stacie Hostetler of the Colo Recreation Board requested that a building be constructed at the Carmody Park field for use as a concession stand. The Council requested additional information on the proposed project.

The Council received a report on the progress of the Sanitary Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Project.

Council member Norgart moved to approve a request to abandon a culvert under Jackie Lane at its intersection with West Street. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed a request to plant trees in City owned right-of-way. The Colo City Code prohibits the planting of trees in right-of-way, and to grant the request would require an ordinance amendment. No action taken.

The Council discussed the problem of low hanging tree branches over streets and sidewalks. The clerk will have an article published in the next city newsletter regarding tree trimming requirements.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Norgart moved to adjourn. Council member Patrick seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
