

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
July 2, 2007

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 2, 2007, at City Hall. Mayor John Foley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Snodgrass, Woods, Wilson, Stoeffler. Absent: Otto.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the June 4, 2007, meeting as presented. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Office, Colo Fire and Rescue, Colo Public Library, Colo Crossroads Festival and the Colo Recreation Board.

Council member Stoeffler presented a proposal for the recreation board to mow the parks. The recreation board will discuss the matter at their July meeting.

Mayor Foley gave a report for the Community Center Planning Committee

The Council discussed possible locations for new outdoor recreation facilities.

Council member Wilson introduced an ORDINANCED AMENDING THE COLO CITY CODE 2007, BY ASSIGNING ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS TO NEWLEY ANNEXED LAND.

Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Snodgrass, Wilson, Stoeffler. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and ordinance approved on second reading.

The council discussed the Drainage Improvement Project. Income surveys have been mailed to Colo residents to determine eligibility for Community Development Block Grant funds.

Snodgrass moved to approve a lease for Niland's café with Sandy Wilfong of State Center. Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Snodgrass moved to adjourn. Council member Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
