

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
July 5, 2011

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, July 5, 2011, at City Hall. It was noted that Tyler Norgart was sworn in as a city council member prior to the meeting. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Norgart, Peakin, Wilson, Short, Woods. Absent: None.

Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Leslie Berckes of Trees Forever presented information on the Community Visioning Program.

The Council received reports from the Colo Public Library, Colo Fire and Rescue and Colo Recreation Board.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the following street closings on July 9, 2011, for the Colo Crossroads Festival: For the parade (9 AM to Noon) Main from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> from Main to Voorhies, Voorhies from 6<sup>th</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> from Voorhies to Main. From 9 AM to 5 PM - 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> from Voorhies to Bailey and Bailey from 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson introduced an ORDINANCE GRANTING INTERSTATE POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY (ALLIANT ENERGY) A 25-YEAR NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO OPERATE AN ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA, and moved its approval on third and final reading. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Woods, Wilson, Short. Nays: None. Abstain: Norgart. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance approved on third and final reading and he gave it number 334 for the record.

Council member Woods introduced an ORDINANCE GRANTING INTERSTATE POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY (ALLIANT ENERGY) A 25-YEAR NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE TO OPERATE A NATURAL GAS DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA, and moved its approval on third and final reading. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Wilson, Short, Peakin. Nays: None. Abstain: Norgart. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and ordinance approved on third and final reading and he gave it number 335 for the record.

The Council reviewed a request to amend the Colo City Code to allow poultry to be kept in a residential zone. No action taken

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Norgart seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
