

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
July 6, 2009

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 6, 2009, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Wilson, Woods, Stoeffler, Dodd. Absent: Short.

Mayor Milleson requested the minutes of the June 1, 2009, meeting be amended to show that he was opposed to the purchase of property located at 302 Warner Street. Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the June 1, 2009, regular meeting as amended per the Mayors request. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Office, Colo Fire & Rescue, and the Colo Crossroads Committee.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the following street closings for the Colo Crossroads Festival: From 5:00 p.m. July 9, 2009, until 7:00 a.m. July 11, 2009, Clayton Road from Elm Street to Oak Street and Oak Street from Clayton Road south to dead end. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Dodd moved to approve payment of \$1500.00 to the Colo Crossroads Festival Committee. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the following street closing for a street dance: Main Street from midway between Third Street and Fourth Street to midway between Fourth Street and Fifth Street, and Fourth Street from Main

Street south to the alley between Main Street and Bailey Street and north from Main Street to the Union Pacific Railroad south row line from 4:00 p.m. on August 28, 2009 until 4:00 A.M. on August 29, 2009. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE SALE OF WATER IN THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Dodd, Stoeffler, Woods. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 09-7-1 for the record.

Council member Stoeffler introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE SALE OF SANITARY SEWER SERVICE IN THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Dodd, Stoeffler, Woods, Wilson. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 09-7-2 for the record.

Council member Dodd moved to approve a contract for Animal Rescue Services with Story County. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson moved to approve change order number 2 for the 2009 CDBG Storm Drainage System Improvements Project. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Stoeffler moved to approve pay estimate number 1 for the 2009 CDBG Storm Drainage System Improvements Project. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Stoeffler gave a report on the Community Center Project. The Council reviewed copies of the architect's drawings and cost estimate.

Council member Woods moved to approve a contract with Manats, Inc. for the 2009 Main Street Resurfacing Project. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Dodd introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTED DEEDS FOR CONVEYANCE OF TITLE TO A PART OF LOTS 10 AND 11, BLOCK 4, THE ORIGINAL TOWN OF COLO, IOWA. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Stoeffler, Woods, Wilson, Dodd. Nays: Done. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it number 09-7-3 for the record.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Stoeffler moved to adjourn. Council member Wilson seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
