July 6, 2015

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, July 6, 2015, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Nichols, Conrad, Milleson. Absent: Geisinger.
