August 2, 2010

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 2, 2010, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Short, Hess, Peakin, Woods. Absent: Wilson.

Council member Woods moved to approve the minutes of the July 6, 2010, meeting as presented. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Fire Chief Mark Farren reviewed fire department activities for the period 1-1-10 thru 6-30-10.

Connie Patrick gave a report on the 2010 Colo Crossroads Festival.

The Council reviewed a proposed drainage plan for the new Casey's General Store facility.

Council member Short introduced an AMENDMENT TO THE COLO CITY CODE (2007) PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF U.S. HWY. 65 FROM BAILEY STREET SOUTH TO THE SOUTH CORPORATE LIMITS and moved its approval on first reading.

Council member Hess seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Hess, Woods, Short. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance approved on first reading.

The Council discussed training opportunities for elected officials for NIMS (National Incident Management System) compliance.

Council member Peakin moved to approve the appointments of Tracy Porter, Nichole Halverson and Sally Thomas to the Colo Library Board with terms ending on 6-30-13. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short moved to approve an Animal Rescue Services Contract with Story County. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes

The Council discussed drainage improvements for the baseball field. Council member Short moved to approve the expenditure of up to \$12,000 for the construction of drainage improvements at the City owned baseball field. Council member Hess seconded the motion and it failed to pass 1 aye, 1 nay and 2 abstain.

The Council reviewed progress on the Lincoln Highway paving project. Construction is complete.

The Council discussed nuisance abatement issues.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Hess moved to adjourn. Council member Short seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
