

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
July 6, 2015

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 3, 2015, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Nichols, Conrad, Geisinger. Absent: Milleson.

Council member Otto seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Story County Sherriff reported it's been a busy month in the county but Colo has been quite. Council member Nichols gave an update on the Colo Crossroads Festival. Becky Johnson will be the new committee chair along with Nancy Tucker. Volunteers are needed.

Joanie Jamison and Brad Snodgrass with the Colo Public Library discussed installing concrete behind the building. Council agreed to budget for concrete and landscaping for next fiscal year.

Council member Otto moved to approve the correspondence from the Story County Animal Shelter regarding City's Animal Control Contract. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad moved to approve the appointment of Dennis Clatt as the fire chief and Rodney Geisinger as the assistant fire chief. Council member Otto seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Discussions were made and agreed upon John Wilson being the appointed member of the E911 Service Board and Dennis Clatt will be the alternate member of the E911 Service Board.

Discussions were made on renaming Bailey Street in honor of the city's past fire chief. All were in agreeance in contacting all citizens with Bailey Street addresses to gather their opinion.

Council member Nichols moved to approve the Becvar building permit. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger moved to approve the Robinson building permit. Council member Otto seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger moved to approve the Crain building permit. Council member Otto seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The clerk gave an update on the street improvement project. A tile at the baseball field has been hit by street improvements. Contractor says it's not his mistake. Council agreed to have Schoppe camera the line. Most items have been completed on the project.

Discussions on a noise ordinance were made.

The clerk reviewed the wastewater inspection with the council. All items inspected were in good standing.

The council discussed residents trimming trees hanging in streets and alleys. The clerk is sending notice to those individuals.

Main Street sidewalks were discussed. Discussion is being tabled to spring.

The clerk gave a report on a citizen wanting to turn their house into a duplex. The clerk is gathering more information with the city attorney.

Housing development locations were discussed. Council is checking into possible locations.

Story County Emergency Management wants cities to have documentation on steps taken if a disaster were ever to hit the community. More information is being gathered.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Geisinger moved to adjourn. Council member Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
