August 6, 2012

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, August 6, 2012, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows:

Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Office, Colo Fire and Rescue, and the Colo Recreation Board.

Missy Bitters and her Cub Scout troop discussed a recent fundraiser the scouts had completed with proceeds going toward the purchase of a new flag pole for the Community Center.

Mayor Wilson informed the Council of new procedures being considered for activation of outdoor warning sirens in Story County.

Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFICIAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE CITY FOR CITY STREETS AND PARKING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2012, AND DIRECTING THE CLERK TO FILE THE REPORT WITH THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. Council member Patrick seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Woods, Norgart, Conrad, Patrick. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution approved and he gave it No. 12-8-1 for the record.

Council member Norgart moved to approve an agreement with the townships of New Albany and Sherman for the operation and maintenance of the Colo Cemetery. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad introduced an ORDINANCE REGULATING GARAGE AND YARD SALES. And moved its approval on third and final reading. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Norgart, Conrad, Patrick, Peakin. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance approved on final reading. The ordinance will be in effect after publication.

Council member Norgart introduced an ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF COLO, IOWA, 2007, BY ADDING A NEW ARTICLE PROVIDING FOR BUILDING NUMBERING and moved its approval on third and final reading. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Norgart, Conrad, Patrick, Peakin, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and ordinance approved on final reading. The ordinance will be in effect after publication.

The Council received an update on the Standby Generator Project. Only one bid was received and the project will be re-advertised.

The Council reviewed the Annual Financial Report for the City. The Council directed the clerk to publish the report.

The Council reviewed projects developed through the Colo Community Visioning Program.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Norgart moved to adjourn. Council member Patrick seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
