September 2, 2008

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 2, 2008, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Woods, Short, Dodd. Absent: Stoeffler, Wilson.

Council member Woods moved to approve the minutes of the August 4, 2008, regular meeting as presented. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriffs Office, Colo Fire and Rescue, Colo Recreation Board and a written report from the Colo Crossroads Committee.

The Council reviewed progress on the storm sewer project. Anthony Bellizzi, the project engineer, gave an update on the project.

Council member Short moved to appoint Tia Cerka to the Colo Recreation Board. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Mayor declared that this was the time and the place for a public hearing to hear comments regarding an amendment to the current fiscal year budget. There were no comments received and the hearing was closed. Council member Woods introduced and moved the approval of a resolution to amend the budget for fiscal year ending 6-30-09. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Dodd, Short. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-9-1 for the record.

Council member Dodd introduced and moved the approval of A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Dodd, Short, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 08-9-2 for the record.

Council member Short moved to approve the annual report to the USDA-Rural Development for the water distribution system. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

Mayor Milleson gave a report on railroad "Quiet Zones".

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Woods moved to adjourn. Council member Short seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
