

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
September 3, 2013

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 3, 2013, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Nichols, Patrick, Norgart, Conrad. Absent: None.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the minutes of the August 5, 2013, meeting as presented. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from Colo Fire & Rescue and the Colo Crossroads Festival Committee.

Council member Nichols introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFICIAL FINANCIAL REPORT OF THE CITY FOR CITY STREETS AND PARKING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2013, AND DIRECTING THE CLERK TO FILE THE REPORT WITH THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Patrick, Peakin, Norgart, Nichols, Conrad. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it No. 13-9-1 for the record.

Council member Norgart moved to approve an agreement between the City of Colo and Faller, Kincheloe & Co, PLC for annual examination for the fiscal year ending 6-30-13. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Nichols moved to approve an annual report for the Colo Water Supply for the United States Department of Agriculture – Rural Development for the fiscal year ending 6-30-13. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad moved to approve a contract with Story County for Animal Rescue Services for the fiscal year ending 6-30-14. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The council reviewed the City's investment policy. Council member Norgart moved to approve the City Investment Policy as submitted. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The clerk reviewed the upcoming city election timetable. The city election will be held on Tuesday, November 5. Voting will be at the Colo Community Center starting at 12:00 noon. Three City Council member seats will be up for election with the first day to file nomination papers August 26<sup>th</sup> and the last day to file will be September 19, 2013, at 5:00 p.m.

The Council received an update on the Community Visioning Program. The visioning steering committee and volunteers planted at the pocket park and slab projects on Saturday, August 24, 2013.

The Council directed the clerk to get a cost estimate for the construction of a chain link fence on the south side of city owned property at block 16 Blair's Addition.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Norgart moved to adjourn. Council member Nichols seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
