

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
September 4, 2007

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 4, 2007, at City Hall. Mayor John Foley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Woods, Wilson, Stoeffler. Absent: Snodgrass.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Colo Public Library, Colo Crossroads Festival and the Colo Recreation Board.

The Council discussed moving the fence adjacent to the south side of the Colo Cemetery to include the newly acquired (Struthers) property. The matter was referred to the Cemetery Board for a recommendation.

Jacob Kaiser presented a proposal to construct a trail on the north side of Carmody Park connecting to West St. This would be a Boy Scout project. Council member Stoeffler moved to fund the project as described by Jacob Kaiser up to \$4500 subject to obtaining the necessary easements from affected property owners. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Otto introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION APPROVING CONTRACT FOR HOUSING REHABILITATION. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Stoeffler, Woods, Otto. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it No. 07-9-1 for the record.

Council member Stoeffler introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLACEMENT OF THE SPECIAL TAX LEVEY IN SUPPORT OF THE COLO PUBLIC LIBRARY ON THE NOVEMBER 6, 2007, BALLOT FOR THE CITY ELECTION. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Stoeffler, Woods, Otto, Wilson. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it No. 07-9-2 for the record.

Mayor Foley gave a report for the Community Center Planning Committee

The council discussed the Drainage Improvement Project.

The Council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Stoeffler moved to adjourn. Council member Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
