September 4, 2012

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 4, 2012, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Norgart, Patrick, Conrad, Woods. Absent: None.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Office, Colo Public Library, Colo Crossroads Committee, and the Colo Recreation Board.

The Council reviewed bids for the standby generator project. Council member Peakin moved to approve a contract with Shipton Diversified Services for the Colo Generator Project to supply and install 1- 100KW Caterpillar/Olympian generator as per specifications and subject to approval of Iowa Homeland Security and Emergency Management Division. Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes

Council member Norgart moved to approve the painting of pedestrian crosswalks on streets intersecting the sidewalk on Sixth Street in order to help promote the use of the Sixth street sidewalk as a safe route to school. Council member Patrick seconded the motion and it passed all ayes

The Council reviewed Colo Community Visioning Program projects. The Community Visioning Steering Committee will meet on Thursday, September 13<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at City Hall.

Mark Patrick requested that the Council consider amending times for open burning and that the Council consider working to silence train whistles on Union Pacific trains passing through Colo.

The Council set the date of Monday, October 1, 2012, for a public hearing for an amendment to the Colo City Code dealing with yard and garage sales.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Peakin moved to adjourn. Council member Norgart seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
