

Proceedings of the Colo City Council  
September 4, 2018

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 4, 2018, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Stoeffler, Spalding, Geisinger, Otto and Handsaker. Absent: none.

Council member Otto moved to approve the minutes of the August 6, 2018 regular meeting and special meeting minutes of August 20, 2018 as presented. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Spalding seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE STREET FINANCIAL REPORT. Council member Handsaker seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Stoeffler, Spalding, Geisinger, Otto, and Handsaker. Nays: none. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it 18-9-1 for the record.

Council member Otto moved to approve the Colo Bar's liquor license. Council member Spalding seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The housing development was discussed. Clerk Kohlwes is getting with City engineer to work on a layout.

The council discussed landscaping options around the new city sign. More information is being gathered.

The Council tabled discussions on the Wilson Auction building.

Discussions on seal coating the alley behind the library. More information is being gathered.

The council discussed leasing or purchasing a tractor or UTV for snow removal. More information is being gathered.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Geisinger moved to adjourn. Council member Handsaker seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
