

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
September 8, 2015

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, September 8, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Otto, Conrad, Geisinger. Absent: Milleson, Nichols.

Council member Conrad moved to approve the minutes of the August 3, 2015, meeting as presented. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Geisinger reported the Cemetery Board approved a new website that should be up and running the first of the year.

Clerk Kohlwes discussed accounting for Colo Crossroads and Colo Cares will need to by the city in order to abide by the state of Iowa's guidelines.

Discussions were made on moving safe deposit box to the State Bank and Trust in Nevada after Colo branch closes. Clerk is gathering information.

Council member Otto moved to approve adding Nancy Tucker to the Colo Crossroads bank account. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Otto moved to approve Fortsch tax abatement application. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Fire Chief, Dennis Clatt stated the department is in the process of purchasing a tack truck to replace the current 1976 truck. The department applied for a FEMA grant to help fund the project.

Extending days of public burning were discussed. It was agreed one day to burn yard waste wasn't feasible. An amended ordinance will be passed in the coming months to add Tuesday from 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. to the year round burning periods.

The clerk gave an update on the street improvement project.

Housing development locations were discussed. Council is checking into possible locations.

Discussions on cleaning and grading of ditches to help with flooding. Further information is being gathered on possible locations.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Council member Geisinger moved to adjourn. Council member Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
