October 4, 2010, 2010

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 4, 2010, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Hess, Woods, Short. Absent: Wilson.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports for the Story County Sheriffs Department and the Colo Recreation Board.

The Council received an update on the City/School comprehensive plan. A survey will be distributed the week of October 4th to seek input from the community.

Council member Hess introduced an ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COLO CITY CODE (2007) PROHIBITING PARKING ON THE WEST SIDE OF U.S. HWY. 65 FROM BAILEY STREET SOUTH TO THE SOUTH CORPORATE LIMITS and moved its approval on third and final reading. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Hess, Woods, Short. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the ordinance approved on third and final reading and he gave it No. 331 for the record.

The Council reviewed progress of the Storm Sewer Project.

The Council reviewed correspondence from the Story County Sheriff regarding an upcoming meeting to discuss law enforcement services contract for the fiscal year ending 6-30-12.

Council member Short moved to approve a beer permit for Casey's General Stores, Inc. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Hess introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE AMES/STORY COUNTY PARTNERSHIP AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF COLO. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Hess, Woods, Short, Peakin. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it No. 10-10-1 for the record.

The Council reviewed nuisance abatement actions.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Hess moved to adjourn. Council member Short seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
