

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
October 5, 2020

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 5, 2020 at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor pro-tem Rodney Geisinger. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Adams, Stoeffler, Geisinger, Bappe. Absent: Spalding, Handsaker.
