October 6, 2008

Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolutions adopted and he gave them Nos. 08-10-1,2, 3 and 4 for the record.

The clerk gave a report on recent television inspection of the sanitary sewer system.

Council member Wilson moved to approve a tax abatement for a building addition at 616 First Street. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short moved to approve a beer permit for Casey's General Stores, Inc. Council member Dodd seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Dodd seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
