October 7, 2013

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, October 7, 2013, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Nichols, Patrick, Conrad. Absent: Norgart.

Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Office and the Colo Crossroads Festival Committee.

Council member Peakin moved to approve a contract with Municipal Pipe Tool Company, LLC for the installation of 1132 feet of cured in place pipe for the sanitary sewer system. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Conrad moved to approve the purchase of a Boss VXT snow plow from Hawkeye Truck Equipment. Council member Nichols seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council discussed the installation of a chain link fence in Block 16, Blair's Addition. No action taken.

The council reviewed the City's investment policy. Council member Nichols moved to approve an update to the City Investment Policy by changing the Iowa Code reference to section 12B and 12C. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received an update on the Community Visioning Program. The visioning steering committee has applied for funds from the Story County Community Foundation to upgrade landscaping at the tennis/basketball court area.

Ed Meller addressed the Council regarding his concerns for loud train whistles and barking dogs.

City clerk/maintenance superintendent Scott Berka advised the Council that he will be retiring in the year 2014.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Peakin moved to adjourn. Council member Nichols seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
