

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
October 17, 2016

The Colo City Council met in special session on Monday, October 17, 2016, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Geisinger, Nichols, Conrad, Spalding. Absent: Otto

At 7:15 p.m. the Mayor declared that this was the time and place for a public hearing on the sale of Lots 9 & 10 at the Colo Business Park. There were no comments received and the hearing was closed.

Council member Nichols introduced RESOLUTION CLOSING THE PUBLIC HEARING, APPROVING THE PROPOSED SALE OF CITY OWNED PROPERTY TO CROPSTAR CONSULTING, LLC AND GRANTING A FIRST RIGHT OF REFUSAL. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Nichols, Spalding, Geisinger, and Conrad. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it No 16-10-3.

Council member Conrad introduced RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXECUTED DEED FROM THE CITY OF COLO TO CROPSTAR CONSULTING, LLC FOR A PORTION OF THE COLO BUSINESS PARK. Council member Geisinger seconded the motion and it passed record vote: Nichols, Spalding, Geisinger, and Conrad. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution was adopted and he gave it No 16-10-4.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Spalding moved to adjourn. Council member Conrad seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
