November 1, 2010

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 1, 2010, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Hess, Woods, Wilson, Short. Absent: None.

Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received a report from the Story County Sheriffs Department.

The Council received an update on the City/School comprehensive plan. Community surveys are still being received for the plan.

The Council received a report from the Christmas in Colo Committee. Council member Wilson moved to approve the expenditure of \$200.00 for the Christmas in Colo event. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council reviewed a request to abandon a part of an alley in the Wilson's Subdivision. No action taken.

Council member Wilson moved to approve a liquor License for Morgan's Famous Main Street Bar subject to payment of required fee and proof of insurance. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION OBLIGATING FUNDS FROM THE URBAN RENEWAL TAX REVENUE FUND. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Woods, Short, Peakin, Hess, Wilson. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it No. 10-11-1 for the record.

Council member Short introduced and moved the adoption of RESOLUTIONS AUTHORIZING CITY CLERK TO CERTIFY MOWING BILL FOR COLLECTION AS TAXES.

Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Short, Peakin, Hess, Wilson, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolutions approved and he gave them No. 10-11-2 and 10-11-3 for the record.

Council member Peakin reported on a recent meeting regarding law enforcement contract rates. The per capita rate for FYE 6-30-12 will increase \$3.25 with additional increases of \$2.50 per capita per year for the next two years.

Mayor Milleson reported on the need to update the City's Hazard Mitigation Plan.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Short moved to adjourn. Council member Woods seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
