

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
November 2, 2015

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 2, at City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor John Wilson. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Conrad, Geisinger, Nichols, Milleson. Absent: Otto.
