November 7, 2011

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, November 7, 2011, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Woods, Norgart, Short, Wilson. Absent: Peakin.

Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Story County Sheriff's Department and Colo Fire and Rescue.

Council member Short moved to allow the Christmas in Colo Committee to place a Christmas tree on City owned property adjacent to the Colo Community Center and to use power from the Community Center to light the tree. Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Wilson moved to approve a liquor license for Morgan's Famous Main Street Bar. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION OBLIGATING FUNDS FROM THE URBAN RENEWAL TAX REVENUE FUND FOR PAYMENT OF ANNUAL TAX INCREMENT FINANCED OBLIGATIONS. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Wilson, Short, Norgart, Woods. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and resolution approved and he gave it number 11-11-1 for the record.

The Council reviewed the Annual Financial Report for the fiscal year ending 6-30-11.

The Council reviewed progress on the installation of standby generators for city owned buildings.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Wilson moved to adjourn. Council member Norgart seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
