

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
December 1, 2008

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, December 1, 2008, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Wilson, Stoeffler, Woods, Short, Dodd. Absent: None.

Council member Wilson moved to approve the minutes of the November 3, 2008, regular meeting as presented. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Colo Recreation Board and Colo Fire and Rescue.

Neil Guess of Howard R. Green Company gave a report on possible options and costs for establishing a quiet zone along the Union Pacific Railroad in Colo.

The Council reviewed the current garbage and refuse pickup contract with Bennett Sanitation of Huxley. Council member Wilson moved to approve a new contract for garbage and refuse pickup with Bennett Sanitation with rates increased by \$.50 per residential pickup per month, \$1.00 per small dumpster per month and \$2.00 per large dumpster per month. All other terms of the contract to remain the same. Council member Stoeffler seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Mayor Milleson gave a report on the winter festival to be held on December 6.

The Council received an update on the Storm Sewer Project. Final plans are scheduled for completion by February 1, 2008.

The Council discussed the status of the Community Center Planning Committee. Council member Short moved to request proposals from qualified consultants for preliminary planning, design and cost estimates for an addition to and the remodeling of the Colo Community Center. Council member Woods seconded the motion and it passed all ayes. Council member Stoeffler volunteered to help with drafting the RFP.

The council reviewed the status of nuisance abatement actions.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Dodd moved to adjourn. Council member Wilson seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
