

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
December 3, 2012

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, December 3, 2012, at City Hall. Mayor John Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. It was noted that Paul Conrad had taken the oath of office for the position of City Council Member prior to the start of the meeting. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Norgart, Patrick, Conrad. Absent: None.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the minutes of the November 5, 2012, meeting as presented. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received reports from the Colo Public Library, Story County Sheriff's Office, Colo Fire & Rescue, and the Colo Recreation Board.

Council member Peakin moved to appoint Doris Otto to the Colo Library Board for a term ending 6-30-15. Council member Conrad seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Norgart introduced and moved the approval of a RESOLUTION TO FILL A VACANCY ON THE COLO CITY COUNCIL BY APPOINTMENT. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed with record vote as follows: Ayes: Peakin, Norgart, Conrad, Patrick. Nays: None. Whereupon the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted and he gave it No. 12-12-1 for the record.

Mayor Wilson administered the oath of office to Diane Nichols for the office of City Council Member.

Representatives of the FC&A requested that the City consider the installation of air conditioning at the city park shelter house. The council directed the city clerk to get cost estimates for same prior to the next regular meeting.

The Council reviewed cost estimates for street improvements for parts of Second, South and Bailey streets. The Council will meet with Tony Bellizzi of Veenstra and Kimm engineers to discuss the improvements at the next regular meeting.

The Council reviewed Colo Community Visioning Program projects. The steering committee has submitted grant applications for trees and plant material for the "Main Street open lot" and the "Slab" projects.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Norgart moved to adjourn. Council member Peakin seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
