

Proceedings of the Colo City Council
December 5, 2011

The Colo City Council met in regular session on Monday, December 5, 2011, at City Hall. Mayor Larry Milleson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present: Peakin, Woods, Norgart, Short, Wilson. Absent: None.

Council member Woods moved to approve the minutes of the November 7, 2011, meeting as presented. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received a report from Colo Fire and Rescue.

Council member Woods moved to make an appointment to the Colo City Council to fill the vacant City Council seat currently held by John Wilson at the January regular meeting, and to direct the clerk to publish notice of the council's intent to fill the seat by appointment. Council member Peakin seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Norgart moved to approve the purchase of a used Case 570 tractor and new blade from Colo Implement Co. for a purchase price of not to exceed \$18,300.00 net including trade for one 480 E Case tractor currently owned by the City. Council member Wilson seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Council member Peakin moved to set the date of December 26, 2011, as the Christmas holiday, January 2, 2012, as the New Years holiday, and January 9, 2012, as the City Council regular meeting date for January 2012. Council member Norgart seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

The Council received an update on the sanitary sewer inflow and infiltration study being conducted by Veenstra & Kimm engineers.

Council member Peakin moved to approved the appointments of Brad Snodgrass and Joyce French to the Colo Library Board. Council member Short seconded the motion and it passed all ayes.

Mayor Milleson administered the oath of office for terms starting 1-1-12 to John C. Wilson, Mayor, and Tyler Norgart, Alex Patrick, and Pat Peakin, City Council members.

There being no further business to come before the meeting Council member Woods moved to adjourn. Council member Norgart seconded the motion. The motion carried and the meeting adjourned.
